

We welcomed everyone by first playing the video of Past International President Patti Hills song 'Today I'm going to try to change the World'. We played this as we thought it was relevant to our awards afternoon. These youth, in their own way are changing the world with their courage to overcome diversity. We started of the event with an ice break where we got everyone in their seat participating in a little exercise. Was great to look around the room to see everyone participating.

We followed this by welcoming everyone and having an hour of fun. We had Glen, John and Keith from a car club come and give the youth and families who wanted to, a ride around Waverley, we had the Bates family with their 2 miniature pony and gigs giving riding around the section behind the rugby room, as well as some games like 1-hole mini putt, bag toss, ring throw etc. It was lovely to watch these 6 young individuals taking part and getting out of their comfort zone.

We had one young girl who has Autism that was hesitant about the ponies and didn't really want to have a ride. Well, we were pleasantly surprised when she decided that she wanted to try and pat a pony, then decided to sit on the gig and then slowing let Levi lead the horse along. I think she even amazed herself. It really brought a tear to the eye. Which is what we wanted to do by providing some fun before we held our ceremony.

Onto the ceremony. Each participant got given a certificate, Lions soft toy and lion chocolate which they were all very appreciative of. One by one we brought them up and presented them with their certificate and gift. The smiles on their faces could be felt around the room. They were really made to feel special.

Hakopa has Cerebral Palsy and Dystonia and is confined to a wheelchair, he received his award for his courage that he displays when taking part in Kapa Haka. He does not let his wheelchair hold him back and his energy doing the haka is a sight to be seen.

Mia also has Cerebral Palsy. She received her award for the amazing courage that she displays when taking part in all the school sporting events and she participate with so much determination and is always the first to offer a hand to others.

Carter has left Hemiplegia and was nominated for the amazing courage he displays when taking part in a range of sporting activities. The confidence, skill and mana that he shows when competing in sports events show the determination and go getter attitude that he has.

Emily found out in March 2023 (when she was 7 yrs old) that she has type 1 Diabetes. Her story is truly inspiring. Within days of the diagnosis, she took the lead in her own care plan. Once back at school Emily was very open about it and talked and taught all her friends and School about her new superpower. The children were going home and telling their parents about it and in turn raising more awareness and growing more people's knowledge. She was so excited when her told her they were going to have a blue day at school for national diabetes day. The whole school came dressed in blue just for her. They raised \$300 for diabetes that day. Emily is a true inspiration and has differently shown courage and determination to not let diabetes define her and to teach and educate others along her journey.

Ayjah has ASD Autism Spectrum Diagnosis. She received her award for her amazing courage that she displays to take part in their school productions and the way she shares her musical talents with others. Standing up and performing in front of people is a big challenge however, she loves to perform and show off her talent to staff and students in the endeavour Centre at school. She is also a great role model for all other students at school.

Jay has Autism Spectrum Diagnosis, and he was nominated for his amazing courage that he displays in taking part in Drama Productions and Speech Competitions. Speaking in front of people is a big challenge for Jay but he takes part in the on act plays that take part at the theatre in Hawera. He also attends weekly speech lessons and is currently aiming for level 3 of his speech exam.

These young students have all deserved their recognitions today. It is great to hear their stories and the courage they have not to let their conditions divine them is courageous.

Thank you to Council Chair Stephen Barr, District Governor Tobi Hipp, 1st Vice District Governor Denis Hurcombe and 2nd Vice District Governor Mike Powell for coming and supporting Robyn and I with this event. Thanks to Glen, John and Keith who took the youth and families for rides around the town, Bates family for providing the Kids Karts for rides for those who chose to. Thanks also the Waverley Lions Club for suppling afternoon tea.

Robyn and I have loved putting the Children of Courage Awards together. What made it even more special was when the youth came to us afterwards and gave us a cuddle and said thank you. It really pulls at the heart strings and the appreciation and gratitude makes us even more determined to keep these awards celebrations happening every year.
